



Certification Maintenance and Renewal

What is the difference between certification maintenance and renewal?

Annual Certification Maintenance:

CSPHA, CSPHC and CSPHP certifications are subject to an annual certification maintenance fee. Fees are established by the Certification Executive Team. Please refer to the [Fee Schedule](#) for payment information.

Certification Renewal:

The renewal cycle for all certificants is 3 years. Certificants must receive professional development hours during each three-year renewal cycle:

- CSPHA – fifteen(15) hours
- CSPHC – twenty four (24) hours
- CSPHP –thirty-six (36) hours

Please track your required Professional Development hours as you earn them so that if you are selected for audit at the end of your three-year cycle, you have your Professional Development information available. Those certificants selected for audit must submit all PD hours on our [PD Hours Tracking Tool](#) along with accompanying verification documentation within 30 days. If a certificant is unable to produce their Professional Development documentation within that time frame, they will have the option of paying for a six-month extension to acquire the missing Professional Development hours. Rates for the extension are determined annually by the Certification Executive Team.

During the extension period, the certification will be considered “suspended” until all requirements have been met. If the certificant fails to meet the Professional Development requirements within the 6-month extension period, their certification will be “terminated” and they will have to reapply through the regular certification process to re-acquire their SPHM certification. ***Please Note:** The time to count hours is reset every three years for all certificants, regardless of being selected for audit or not.

Any appeals for denial of Professional Development hours will be addressed through the ASPHP Appeals Process.
